**DEPARTMENT RULES**

1. General rules and regulations and health requirements listed on the Iowa State Fair website and in the FFA section apply in this department, with special emphasis on the following sections: Member Eligibility, Supervision and Lodging, Good Conduct Policy, Medication and Drug Testing, and Showing and Fitting Ethics.
2. **Nominations must be submitted online on or before May 15.** A maximum of 15 head may be nominated.
3. Dairy goats must be owned by the nomination due date by the exhibitor, or in a partnership or a corporation. Ownership must be maintained from the nomination date through the exhibition date of the Iowa State Fair.
4. All purebred and recorded grades dairy goats must be permanently tattooed by the nomination due date. Grades must be tattooed or ear tagged.
5. **Entries must be submitted online on or before July 1.** Entry fee is \$3.00 per head. Each exhibitor may enter two animal per class with a maximum of six animals for the entire show. Plan up to four animals per pen.
6. This show is sanctioned by ADGA, and their rules shall govern. Junior and Senior shows are not separately sanctioned.
7. The Grades Division will be shown separately before the ADGA Sanctioned Show.
8. All Youth Dairy Goats must be housed in the Swine Barn.
9. Milk out time will be at the discretion of the exhibitor. However, the judge has the right to disqualify exhibitors if animals are not handled in a humane manner.
10. Junior Does are under the age of 24 months that are not in milk and have never freshened. Senior Does are in milk or have freshened.
11. Does that are 24 months of age or older and have not freshened shall not be shown.
12. Premiums will be paid on a basis of \$5, 4, 3, and 2 for all others.
13. A purple, blue, red or white ribbon will be awarded to each entry. Placing ribbons will be provided to the top ten places in each class. Rosettes will be awarded to Junior and Senior Champions and Reserve Champions in each Division. Division Grand Champions will receive rosettes. **Only purple and blue ribbon winners can be named champion of show/division/class.**
14. The Overall Best Doe of Show will be selected in the ADGA Sanctioned Show from the recorded grade and purebred classes. The Best Doe of Show will be awarded a trophy.

The premiums are based on a point system. A committee will tabulate the results during the progress of the show.
