RULES

1. Open Class Livestock general rules, regulations and health requirements apply in this department. In case general rules conflict with Llama Department general or special rules, the latter shall govern. This show is also governed by the ILR Show Division guidelines.
2. **SUBMITTING ENTRIES.** Entries may be made online at www.iowastatefairentory.org. Entries may also be made by printing the form available at www.iowastatefair.org. Complete entry form and return it with **full payment** of all fees to: Iowa State Fair, Llama Department, P.O. Box 57130, Des Moines, Iowa 50317-0003. **Llama registration information must be listed on the entry form. Unnamed entries will not be accepted.** ALSO REGISTER ON ILR WEBSITE: www.lamaregistry.com.
3. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1.** ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE OR POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE **JULY 1.**
4. **ENTRY FEES.** Each exhibitor, as a requirement for entry, will pay an entry fee of \$15 per animal and \$5 per class. **Entry Fee must accompany entry or it will be returned.**
5. **LATE ENTRIES.** Entries submitted online or postmarked July 2 - July 8 will be charged a late fee of \$10 per head in addition to regular entry fees. No entries will be accepted after July 8. Entries are accepted according to earliest postmark.
6. **REFUNDS.** No refunds of fees will be made unless cancellation is received **IN WRITING** (letter, fax or e-mail) by July 21. No refunds will be given on tickets, wristbands or vehicle permits. No refunds of \$5.00 or less will be issued. Refunds will be made by mail after the close of the Fair (separate from premium checks).
7. **ADMISSION TO THE FAIR.** Each exhibitor must purchase two discounted admission tickets at \$8 each when making entry. Additional tickets may be purchased. Discounted tickets for children 6-11 years old may be purchased for \$4 each. Without admission tickets, the full price of \$12 (adults) and \$6 (children) per day will be charged at the gate.
8. **UNLOAD PERMITS.** Each exhibitor will be given one unload permit. This permit allows a maximum of 30 minutes to unload animals and tack but does **not** provide parking.
9. **VEHICLE PERMITS.** Each exhibitor may purchase a vehicle parking permit at \$10 per day. Each exhibitor is limited to two ongrounds lot permits per day. Any additional passes will be issued for Lot Y. Vehicle permits must be purchased in advance by indicating the specific days needed on the Llama Entry Form. Each vehicle permit will park one car or truck (**no trailers**) in a Fairgrounds lot for the specified day(s). **Vehicle permits are required to park in Fairgrounds lots on a space available basis. Parking will not be available at the gate.**
10. **Additional ILR Show Division fees: All exhibitors must pay \$3 per animal for ILR Show Manager Fee.**
11. **Animals with pending ILR numbers at time of entry MUST have registration papers turned in at time of check in or the animal will be disqualified. No animal will be shown without a valid ILR number. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.**
12. Llamas may be entered in more than one class. **However, a llama can go through the course only one time in Freestyle, Obstacle, Trail/Pack, and PR/Companion classes. Animals can not show in both Adult and Youth Performance classes.**
13. The "Little Britches" class is for persons ages 4 to 6. **No class entry fee - No premium!** Participation ribbons only. One "Spotter" per animal will be allowed in the ring during the class. Class will not be placed. Judged as a Showmanship Class and Obstacle Class.
14. **HALTER CLASSES.** Classes will be divided into Light, Medium, Heavy, Silky and Suri wool classes. Wool classes may be combined. See ILR website (www.lamaregistry.com) for wool descriptions.
15. Premiums will be awarded as follows in each class (excluding Little Britches and Championship): \$30, 20, 10, Ribbon, Ribbon. Ribbons only in Little Britches. Rosettes to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
16. A **Best of Show Llama** will be selected from the Grand Champion females and males in the Light Wool, Medium Wool, Heavy Wool, Silky Wool, Suri Wool, Non-Breeders and Miniature Divisions. Grand and Reserve Performance Champions in each age level will be awarded ribbons.
