RULES AND CONTEST INFORMATION

1. Open to any person of any age.
2. No advance entry required.
3. Out-of-state contestants are welcome.
4. Three judges will place the awards.
5. Contestants must play three selections. Ties will be played off on a three tune basis. Superintendent reserves the right to change format due to time constraints.
6. Contestants must play by ear or from memory.
7. One accompanist is allowed to be furnished by the contestant.
8. Electrified instruments will not be allowed.
9. Position on the program will be decided by the number given to each contestant at time of registration.
10. Prizes will be awarded strictly on ability based on a point system. Ribbons will be awarded and winners will be announced at the end of each contest.
